



PENGUINS SWIMMING CLUB

REGISTRATION PROCESS & CLUB FEES 2020/2021 SEASON TERMS & CONDITIONS

Please read the following information and contact PSC should you have any queries. Upon registration with PSC for the 2020/2021 season, you will be required to tick a box to confirm you have read, understood and agree to abide by the Terms and Conditions set out below.

REGISTRATION PROCESS

Registration with Penguins Swimming Club (hereafter referred to as PSC) is compulsory for **every** existing and new club member each season. This means no matter the age **every** swimmer needs to be registered with PSC.

The steps for registration are as follows:

1. **NEW MEMBERS** are to establish which coach the swimmer(s) will train with and at which venue. This is done by contacting PSC for coaches details and then contacting the coach to attend a "trial" swim session. Once a Coach is chosen, then:
2. **NEW AND EXISTING MEMBERS** to complete a Club Registration Form for **each** swimmer online. A hard copy can be given to you by your coach at the pool, or you can download a copy from the website to complete or you can register online from 1 May 2020. 3. The completed Club Registration Form MUST be done online or a hardcopy returned **within the first week** that the swimmer is training at PSC.
4. On receipt of the Registration Form, you will be emailed an invoice for Club Registration Fees that will cover from the month the swimmer has started training until 30 April 2021.

CLUB REGISTRATION FEES

Registration Fees are charged to every swimmer training with PSC and cover the entire season from the month that the swimmer begins training. No refunds of Club Registration Fees will be given if a swimmer discontinues training with PSC; or misses numerous sessions due to illness, personal schedules or vacations.

Registration Fees are not billed monthly. The full amount will be billed in the first month that the swimmer trains at PSC. Registration Fees can, if necessary, be paid off over a maximum of 3 months. Please email secretary@penguinssc.co.za to make this arrangement. All arrangements will be handled confidentially.

No swimmer will be able to participate in Club Night Galas or the end of season Club Championship Gala in March of each year, nor be awarded any prize at the annual end of season AGM/Prizegiving of that year, should registrations and/or accounts be outstanding.

Club Night galas are open to all registered and paid up members. "Visitors" are also welcome, but are not considered a "Visitor" if swimming with a Penguins Coach.

PENGUINS SWIMMING CLUB

All Competitive Swimmers are expected to train through winter.

Registration with KZN Aquatics (KZNA) is done in May 2020 and galas begin in June/July 2020.

Swimmers joining PSC as a Competitive Swimmer part way through the season (either as a PSC non-competitive member or from a different Club) will be charged a reasonable pro-rata fee depending on the month they join.

Swimmers registering as Competitive for the first time, will need to supply a copy of their ID along with the completed KZNA Registration form.

****The Registration Fee for KZNA is paid to PSC at the time of Registration. Please email your proof of payment together with the completed KZNA Registration Form to PSC; along with a parent's KZN Timekeeper/Judge Registration Form.**

The KZNA Registration will not be processed until payment is received in full.

COMPETITIVE SWIMMERS – OFFICIALS (TIMEKEEPERS & JUDGES)

Every competitive swimmer is required to have a parent timekeeper/official throughout the season at every gala they participate in. The more officials the club has the better it is to share the duties out at each gala.

1 May 2020 – 30 April 2021: 2020/2021 - R140 (Before 30 June 2020)

1 May 2020 – 30 April 2021: 2020/2021 - R150 (Before 01 July 2020)

Any parent who has not completed the officials course must please do so as early into the season as possible. Please chat to your coach so your name can be put on the list. As soon as a course comes up you will receive information to attend.

If a parent can't fulfil an official duty that they are rostered for, it is up to the parent to arrange an alternative to cover them. This is not the clubs responsibility.

Joining any time after 1 Jan 2020: R480

COACHING FEES

Coaching fees are paid to the coach directly on a monthly basis, and not to PSC. Should a swimmer cease training with PSC, then **one (1) months** written notice is due to the coach for Non-competitive swimmers and **three (3) months** written notice for Competitive swimmers. Unless this notice is given, the swimmer remains accountable for fees owing. In the event of a swimmer ceasing training with PSC, the Club Registration fees remain payable as per the invoice issued.

CLUB KIT

Competitive swimmers are expected to wear their Club cap and T-shirt when representing PSC at any KZNA Gala or Club Competitions. Kit is to be purchased by new Competitive Swimmers on registration.

Non-competitive swimmers are expected to wear their Club Coach's cap at all Club Galas.

Club cap will only be issued to new swimmers, upon receipt of a **completed registration form and full payment** of Club Registration Fees.
